Registered Dietitian – Full Time or Part Time, 18-month maternity leave replacement

Position Summary

The Georgina Nurse Practitioner Led Clinic provides primary health care services to the residents of Georgina with outreach services to two local schools, two local shelters and Georgina Island.

The *Registered Dietitian (RD)* ensures that high quality nutritional care is delivered, consistent with the philosophy and standards of the Georgina NPLC and the College of Dietitians of Ontario. The Registered Dietitian is responsible for providing comprehensive nutritional care for patients and their families through education, guidance, and counseling. In addition, the Dietitian is required to contribute to program planning, implementation and evaluation in a multidisciplinary team concept.

Key Areas of Responsibility and Duties

- 1) Work within the scope of practice of the RD, within the expectations of the College of Dietitians of Ontario and the Regulated Health Professions Act
- 2) Develop, utilize and evaluate a care plan for nutritional assessment, intervention, and follow-up of all patients referred to them by the Primary Care NP and other partner providers
- 3) Practice individually and collaboratively with health care team to determine nutritional needs of patients, and assist with problem solving and monitoring for complicated patient's health related issues
- 4) Schedule patient consultations with the patient/family
- 5) Establish and support nutrition screening programs for GNPLC patients
- 6) Develop, facilitate and evaluate in-person or virtual nutrition and food skills programs for patients
- 7) Provide nutritional consultative support to health professionals, dietetic interns, community groups, government, media and individuals
- 8) Use reliable and up to date nutrition education resources, and if need be, develop and distribute nutrition specific educational materials
- 9) Increase public awareness in relation to nutrition/healthy living through public displays, community workshops, and liaison with other service providers
- 10) Keep abreast of current knowledge and trends related to dietetics including clinical practice guidelines in order to improve practice outcomes
- 11) Acts as a resource within the Georgina NPLC on nutrition related issues
- 12) Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as required

The above duties are representative but are not to be considered all-inclusive.

Job Requirements

- Ability to travel within the community
- Adhere to Occupational Health and Safety policies and procedures as per applicable legislation
- Adhere to all policies and procedures of the Georgina NPLC
- Ability to work flexible work hours

Physical Demands

- Majority of time will be spent with clients within the office or meeting room
- Moderate: The position requires minimal physical effort and the workday comprises roughly equal amounts of standing and sitting, with frequent position changes.
- Requirement to wear a mask when patient-facing or interacting with other team members
- Travel within the community

Qualifications

- Completion of a Bachelor's Degree in Nutrition, Dietetics, or related field and a graduate of an Accredited Dietetic Internship or combined Master's and Dietetic Internship program
- Mandatory Registration with the College of Dietitians of Ontario and possess professional liability insurance
- Clinical experience 3-5 years – in the community an asset
- Certified Diabetes Educator (CDE) is an asset
- Experience with eating disorders management is an asset
- Interest or experience in smoking cessation counselling an asset
- Proven ability to work independently and in a multidisciplinary team, take direction from various sources and prioritize workload.
- Exceptional understanding of current, evidence based and best practice guidelines
- Experience in program design, delivery and evaluation an asset
- Proficient in use of computers and information technology
- Experience with social media and website design an asset
- Experience with electronic medical records system is an asset
- Current Ontario Driver's License
- Current BCLS
